International Travel Waiver of Liability:

Denied Boarding Information: Don't Let This Happen to You! . .

Check in for international flights begins 3 hours prior to departure. You must check in no later than 2 hours prior to departure or risk being denied boarding. No passengers can be accepted for check in less than 60 minutes prior to flight time. You must present yourself at the boarding gate at least 30 minutes prior to departure.

Passport: A valid passport book is required for all passengers (including infants) on all international flights. Passport Cards are not valid for air travel to any international destinations. Most international countries require that passports be valid for 6 months beyond your scheduled travel dates. Non-US citizens may also require a visa for travel on Jonesboro Travel packages. Check with the consulate of your intended destination as well as the US to ensure that you have proper documents to travel. Some countries require a single parent traveling with minor children (or minors traveling alone) to present additional documents (notarized permission letter, death certificate, sole custody papers or "father unknown" documents) to enter the country.

Importance of Proper Documents: It is the client's responsibility to obtain and have in your possession proper and valid documentation required for entry and departure for each country you travel. You are solely responsible for the cost incurred during travel for missing, incomplete, or defective documentation. Jonesboro Travel (and/or the tour operator if applicable) is not liable for any loss or expense incurred due to loss, damage, or errant entry, exit or travel documentation. Jonesboro Travel (or the tour operator if applicable) requires your passport details AT THE TIME OF BOOKING (if available) for all international travel. It is the client's responsibility to provide accurate information on names, dates of birth, passport numbers, and expiration dates to Jonesboro Travel; inaccurate information given may result in additional fees or penalties. Most airlines will not allow name changes which may result in the termination of the airline ticket. Clients without appropriate documentation are subject to fees, and may be prevented from boarding airlines or ships, or from disembarking in certain ports. Jonesboro Travel requires clients to be personally responsible for presenting all required documents, including passports, visas, and proof of vaccinations (if required). Jonesboro Travel cannot be held responsible for fees, costs, penalties, or interrupted or terminated trips due to a lack of proper documentation, nor can we offer refunds to guests who fail to comply with documentation requirements.

JONESBORO TRAVEL cannot accept liability for any passenger refused entry onto any transport or into any country due to failure of the passenger to carry correct documentation or adhere to specific entry and exit requirements, including criminal records or DWI/DUI(such as entry in Canada, Australia & New Zealand).
